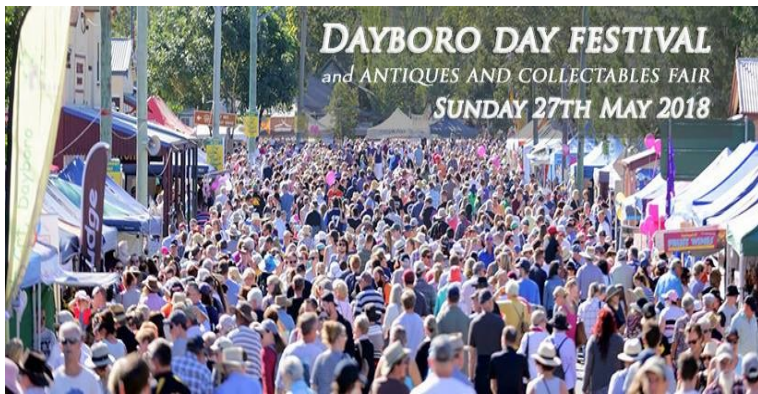
Activities begin at 4pm, and include the food trucks, live music, a free children's craft activity where kids can make

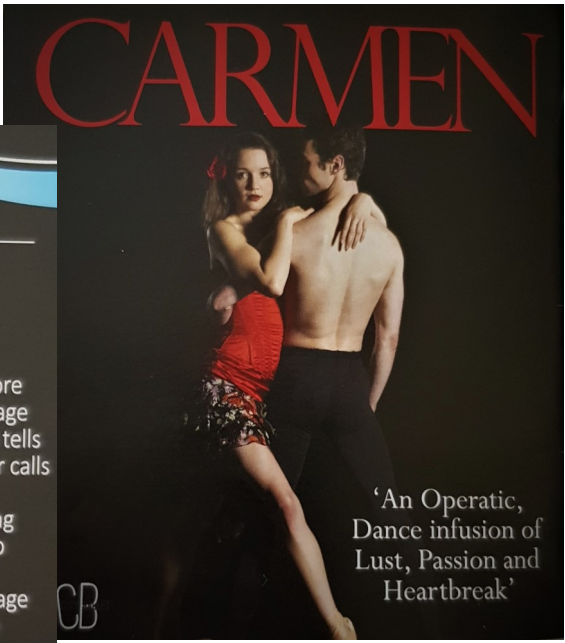
